Some people gesture.





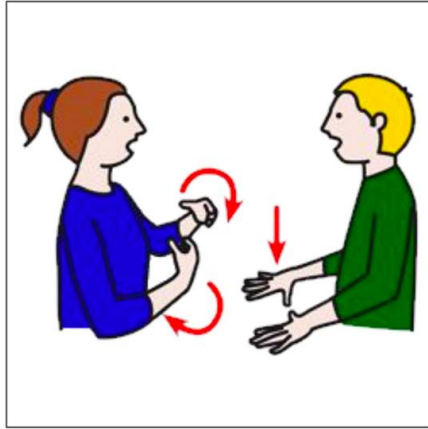
Some people dance.



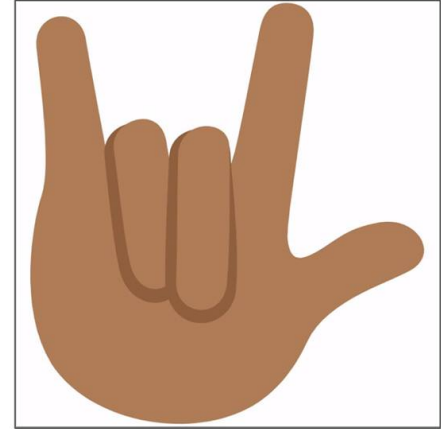


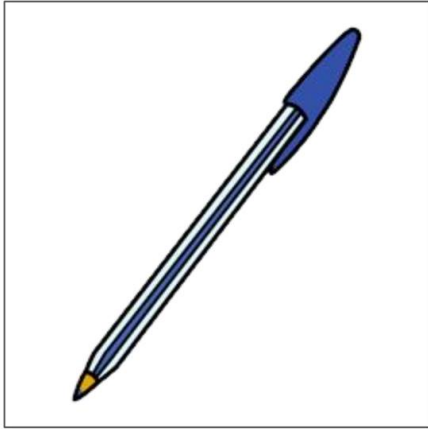
